In the name of God Amen, I Thomas Ewell being weak of body but of sound mind thanks be to God for the same doo constitute make and publish this to bee my last will and testament revoking thereby all other or former wills that is to say I will and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Cina Greggs all my real and personal property now in the county of Dilaware and Henry County state of Indianna consisting to the best of my recollection of three eighty acre lotts of land to gether with some obligations that I left in the hands of my son John Ewell which devise in made to my beloved daughter for the purpose of Enabling my daughter Cina Greggs to support and take care of me during my Natural life and lastley I doo hereby appoint my daughter Cina Griggs the executrix of this my last will and testament. Given under my hand and seal this 23 day of May 1844.
